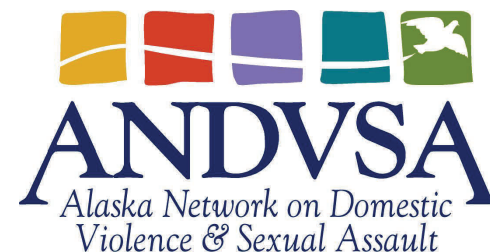

Technical Assistance:

The LAP assists domestic violence & sexual assault programs to develop policies and protocols.

We provide advocates with legal technical assistance and have provided over **20,460** case consultations since 1996.

Legal Trainings For Advocates and Attorneys:

1,500 individuals trained since 1996 through annual CLE and advocacy trainings.

The LAP Coordinates:

- Annual Continuing Legal Education Conference on domestic violence and sexual assault for attorneys
- Annual statewide training for legal advocates

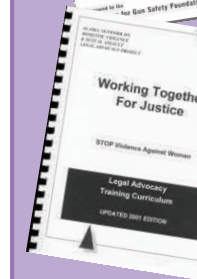
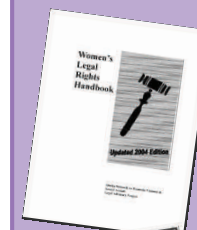
